Trinity Yachts M/Y FINISH LINE Wins World Superyacht Award **Two-Deck Semi-Displacement Category**

5 May 2014, Gulfport, Mississippi: Trinity Yachts is pleased to announce that *Finish Line*, its custom designed 120' (36.7m) raised pilothouse superyacht with aluminum hull and superstructure, has won the World Superyacht 2014 Neptune Award in the *Two-Deck Semi-Displacement* category. The ninth annual World Superyacht Awards took place 3 May 2014 in Amsterdam, The Netherlands. Judges are comprised of 20 current and former yacht owners and two independent specialists.



In a near unanimous decision, *Finish Line* was deemed the winner based on a number of determining factors: performance, customization to owner specification, arrangement of decks and interior, build quality and exterior styling. The finalist class in the category included three aluminum and two composite-built yachts, all of comparable size.

“To win the Neptune for *Finish Line* is deeply gratifying for us,” says John Dane III, Trinity Yachts President. “Heralded since the day she took delivery, she represents many things: the commitment Trinity has to custom superyacht construction; a truly patriotic American owner; astounding performance and breakthrough engineering in a yacht her size; and the creation of jobs here in the U.S. On behalf of *Finish Line*’s owner and all of the employees at the yard, we thank the judges and the World Superyachts Awards for this honor.”
